INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Safety Warnings

- This product is only suitable for connection to a 240V~50Hz supply in accordance with current IEE wiring regulations. It is for indoor use only, and not suitable for a bathroom location.
- This is a Class II, Double Insulated \square product and must not be earthed.
- Do not plug into the mains until your lamp is fully assembled.
- Under no circumstances must this lamp be covered with any material as this could pose a safety hazard. It must be used on a stable, flat surface.
- Never fit bulbs of a higher wattage than those specified on the label (as these may cause overheating and damage the fitting).
- The lamp must be protected by a 3 amp fuse in the mains plug.
- If the mains cable becomes damaged it must only be replaced by a technically competent, qualified person.
- If you are in any doubt about your competence please consult a qualified electrician.
- This products may contain delicate parts be careful during handling and maintenance to avoid breakage.
- If any modification is made it will invalidate the warranty and may render the product unsafe.

Care Information

Allow 10 minutes to cool before replacing, adjusting or cleaning.

Clean with a dry cloth only. Do not use liquid or abrasive cleaners on this product.

Assembly/User Instructions

Before you start

Please read these instructions carefully before fitting and retain for reference. Check the packaging and make sure that you have all the required parts. Follow each assembly step in order to prevent incorrect assembly. Ensure that the product is fully assembled as illustrated before use. Your standard lamp has been packaged as separate parts to prevent damage during transit.

These assembly diagrams are intended as a guide. While all the steps to assemble your fitting will be the same, your individual product may vary from the diagram shown below. If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

- 1. Do not attempt to plug in or use this product until it has been fully assembled. Disconnect from mains during assembly or maintenance.
- 2. Remove all packaging from the base section (A), central tube (B) and upper section (C).
- 3. Gently pull any excess cable through from through from the side of central tube (B). Then turn tube B anticlockwise approximately 6 times (Turning the tubes anticlockwise first ensures that the cable will straighten when the tubes are fully assembled).
- 4. Screw tube B on to the upper section (C) in a clockwise direction. Then screw the assembly in a clockwise direction on to the base (A). Take care not to trap the cable or cross the threads, firmly tighten the tube by hand.
- 5. Stand the product upright and check the tightness of the joints by hand.
- 6. Install the bulbs (D). Do not install a bulb with a greater wattage or different shape than specified on the label.
- 7. Screw the shades (E) onto the threaded lampholders (F) to secure in place. Do not overtighten
- 8. Plug in, and operate the foot switch (G) to turn your lamp on.

If your lamp will not illuminate, please check the bulb, the 3 amp fuse in the plug and ultimately check the relevant fuse in your fuse box. If unsuccessful please consult your retailer.
