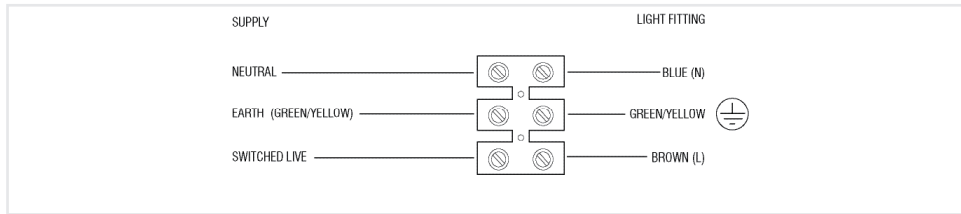


Wiring

Having correctly identified the wiring from your existing light fitting, pull the wire through the hole and connect to the connection block inside the product in the following way:



Check that...

- You have correctly identified the wires.
- The connections are tight.
- No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.
- When completed, ensure that there are no bare or loose strands of wire exposed, and cover all exposed areas of the connection block with 2 layers of insulation tape.

Care and Safety

- We recommend cleaning with a soft dry cloth. Do not use solvents or abrasive cleaners as these could damage the finish.
- For your safety, always switch off the supply before cleaning.

Thank you for purchasing this light fitting. Please read the instructions carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product. Please retain these instructions for future reference.

Warning

Please read these instructions carefully before commencing any work.

This unit must be fitted by a competent and qualified electrician.

Install in accordance with IEE Wiring regulations and current Building Regulations.

Check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts listed.

To prevent electrocution switch off at mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge.

This light fitting should be connected to a fused circuit.

If replacing an existing fitting, make a careful note of the connections.

Cables must be protected using suitable conduit or plastic trunking.

The product must be securely fixed to the mounting surface using the screws and wall plugs supplied. The screws and wall plugs supplied are suitable for "masonry" only. Other fixings not supplied and must be purchased.





Take care not to drill into any pipes or mains cables beneath the surface during mounting holes preparation.

Never put anything on the product or hang anything on any part of this product

Care must be taken when fitting or handling to prevent personal injury or damage to the product.

Choose a suitable location for installing the product, away from trees, hot ventilator ducts, street lighting and traffic, which may interfere with its operation.

Installation

Existing fittings must be completely removed before installation of a new product. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.

- Note that the power needs to be isolated/switched off at the fuse board.
- This product is rated IP44 ((definition e.g. splash proof / rain proof etc). It is suitable for use outdoors but should not be immersed in water / sited in areas likely to be heavily splashed, either from above or below, or subjected to standing water.
- Use the product to draw two fixed mounting points.
- Connect the product to the power supply – see wiring details. **NOTE:** This is a Class I fitting and must be earthed. Any loose terminal block –not secured to ceiling cup - should always be covered with 2 layers of good quality insulation tape.
- Using the screws and wall plugs supplied fixed the product to the mounting surface.
- Follow the diagram below to install the product.
